2011 award for distinguished career in VCP

- Jean Pierre Braun (Toulouse FR)
- Founding member of the society and the college professor in the vet school of Toulouse, mainly involved in different areas of biochemistry and biophysics.
- His research activity mainly focused on kidney testing and clinical enzymology
- More than 110 papers in PubMed

2011 award for distinguished career in VCP

- Harold Tvedten (Uppsala, Sweden)
- Founding member of the ECVCP
- Worked for many years at Michigan University then he moved to Sweden
- Authors of hundreds of papers in indexed journal and of a dozen of books in different fields of haematology and cytology

2011 award for distinguished career in VCP

- Mary Christopher
- Professor of Veterinary Clinical Pathology at Davis University
- Editor in Chief of the Veterinary Clinical Pathology Journal, contributing in the development of the discipline worldwide
- Authors of a hundred of papers and member of the ESVCP and ECVCP

2011 award for distinguished career in VCP

- Jiro Jerry Kaneko
- Spent his career in UC Davis, working on different aspect of veterinary clinical biochemistry
